About A-PDF Backup Master

Do you know that data loss is a very common experience of computer users and 67% of internet users have suffered serious data loss? How to protect your important computer data in a safe and easy way?

You can use some tool to back up copies of your important data to any local or network location every day or every week. So once the data loss happens to your computer, you can recover data easily with backup copies.

A-PDF Backup Master is useful backup software to help you protect your computer data with ease. This powerful program will enable you to back up all your files, like hiberfil.sys files, pagefile.sys files, temporary files and even hidden files. You can choose manually backup or have the program automatically back up files for you every day, every week or every month. Then you can restore data after deleting or corrupting, or recover data from a historical period of time.

A-PDF Backup Master program is very easy to use. You can create backup project in clear wizard interfaces, choose back up files in local, network even FTP folder, set detail filters on which files to be backup or not, etc..

A-PDF Backup Master allows you to copy, upload, download data automatically on schedule from your PC to various storages ?network disks, remote FTP servers, etc. The program can either mirror your data "as is" or create archived files or directories for copying.

A built-in task scheduler helps you to build a queue of automated backups, uploads, downloads, or run third-party utilities to process the data before or after copying/archiving.

Detail features include:

- Backup files to protect your important data on computer.
- Define destination folder of backup as Local, Network or FTP folder.

- Backup all files include hiberfil.sys files, pagefile.sys files, temporary files and hidden files.
- Set filter to choose which kind of files not to be back up.
- Full Backup or Differential Backup.
- Manually backup or automatically backup after a certain term.
- View statistics, backup versions, summary of back up tasks separately.
- Restore last version or some special version back up before.
- Set default back up destination and log store folder.

A-PDF Backup Master can be started either by launching the application via the desktop short cut , or directly from Windows Explorer.

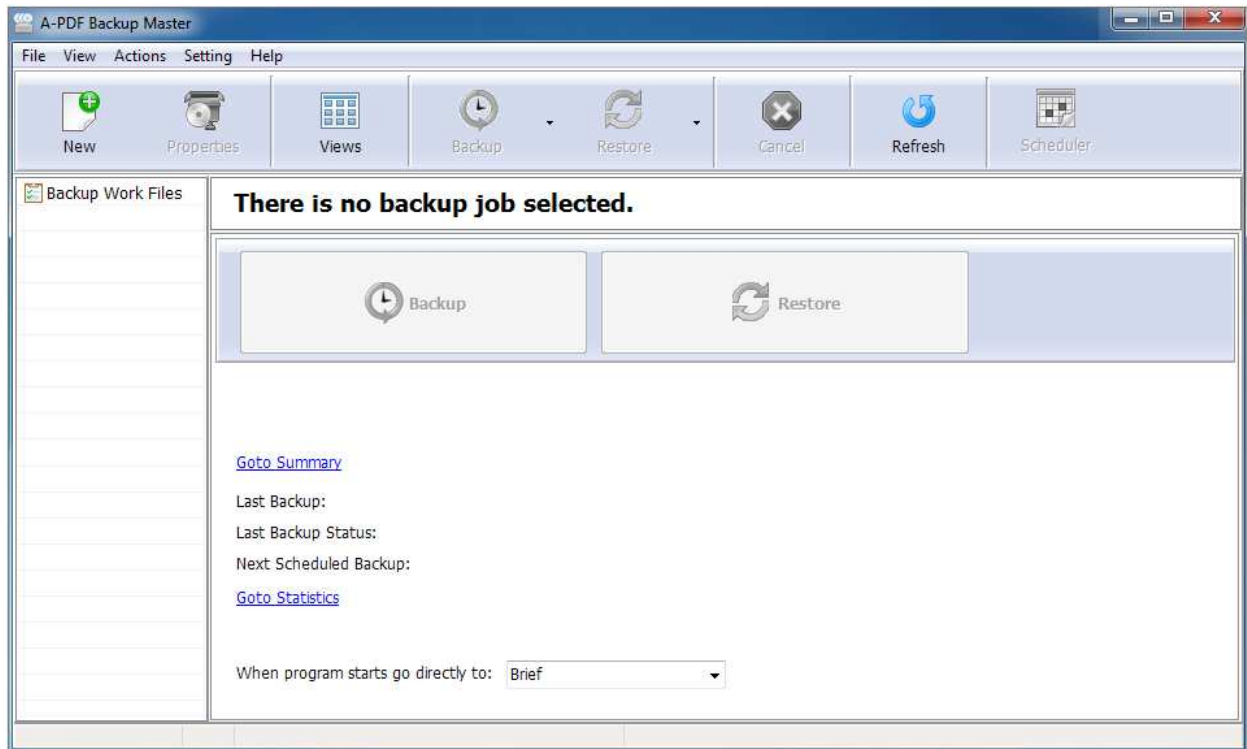
Start the program, you will see the below initial window:

1. New Backup



Click "New" icon to create a backup task with wizard interfaces:

(1) Backup Where:

Define Backup Name of this task, then choose destination folder for back up files. You can store the files locally, in Network or FTP directly:

(2) Backup What:

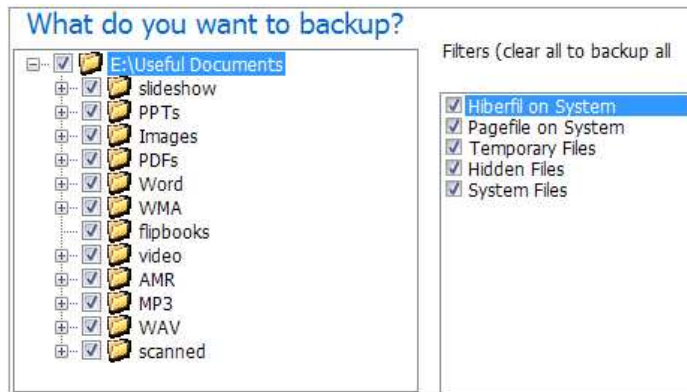

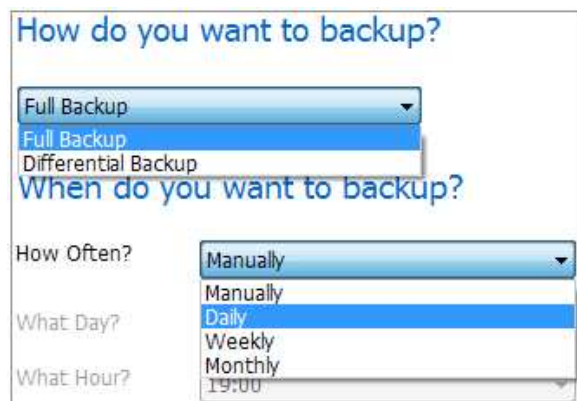

(3) How to backup:

You can define backup modes as you will, full backup each time or just back differential files, backup manually or automatically every day or every week even every month, and how frequently you back up will depend on how often you use your PC and what you use it for:



(4) Advanced settings:

Click "Advanced" icon to enter into detail properties setting interface. Beside above back up settings, you can set description of this backup and detail filters on files, folders and even attributes:

At last, click "Save" button to save all the backup settings. If you want to modify the settings, just choose



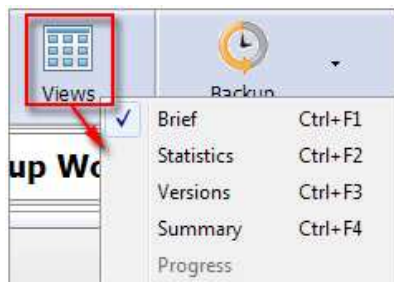
the task in left panel and then click "Properties" icon to change as you will, or directly click



"Schedule" Scheduler to set another backup mode for the task.

2. View Style

After back up files, you can view the progress details through different view styles:







(1) Brief

"Brief" is the main view interface, you can get synoptic information about the backup task, such as backup destination, last backup time and status, you can click "Go to Summary" or "Go to Statistics" to enter into other view interfaces.

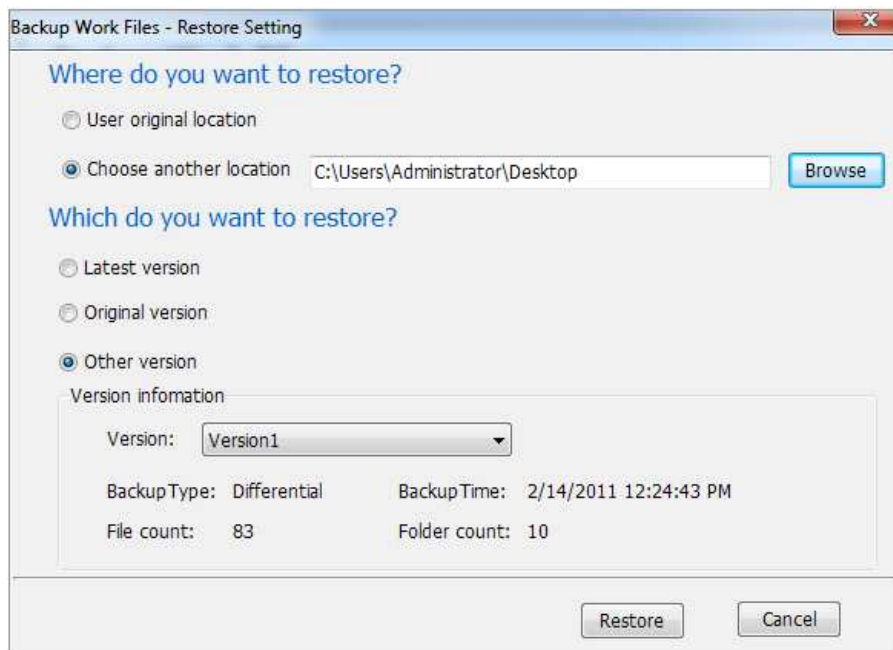

3. Restore

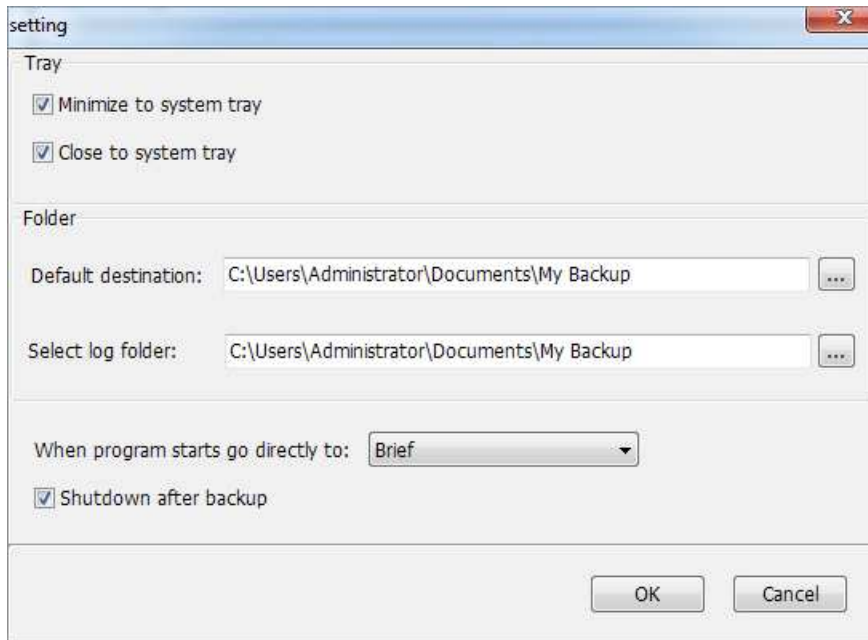


Click "Restore" icon to recover data saved before. You can choose restore location and which version to restore.



4. Program Settings
