About A-PDF Content Splitter Service

A-PDF Content Splitter Service is a windows services program that can running in the background, you can use the services to batch Split existing Acrobat PDF files based on text content withy in PDF in sequence automatically.

A-PDF Content Splitter Service can folders watch every few seconds and process files in single or multiple folder(s), it can split PDF files automatically when the files are written to a specified monitored folders

Professional features included:

- Supports multiple folder watch and settings
- Supports Save profile setup

All these settings are stored in a profile setup, you can have as many profiles as you like. To meet your most splitting PDF needs.

A-PDF Content Splitter Service works with does NOT require Adobe Acrobat. But it need A-PDF Content Splitter (http://www.a-pdf.com/content-splitter/index.htm) to define split Rules

Using A-PDF Content Splitter Service

Ok presuming you've just installed A-PDF Content Splitter Services, you should have a icon on your desktop with the A-PDF Content Splitter Services Settings Logo, like the below right screen shot. When you start the Settings program, you will be presented with the screen shot.





Start & Stop A-PDF Content Splitter Service

In the Settings program, you can click '**<u>Start'</u> & '<u>Stop'</u>**, to start & stop A-PDF Content Splitter Services

By default, the installed service will be started automatically when you reboot the computer. You can also start and shutdown the service from the **Control Panel** using the Services icon. When the service is started, it will create all the processes you defined in the settings one by one. When the service is shutdown, it will terminate each of the processes it created (in reverse order).



Setting the Hot Directory

• Add Watched Folder

Click 'Add Folder..', a hot directory setting window will be opened.

Hot Directory Setting:

- Monitor Directory: set the directory to monitor. Even Include Sub-Directory.
- **Output Directory**: set output directory where all of splitted files will be sent to.
- Log File Directory: Log files will be saved in. Log files will record the detail of operation. Such as when to monitor, which file being splitted, if splitting successfully or not.

• **Backup Directory**: if check this option, the original PDF file will be move to the directory after splitted.

After setting the directories and security method of output files, click **OK** button to save settings, **cancel** button to quit without saving.

• Remove Watched Folder

If you want to remove a folder, select the folder and click **'Remove Folder'**. Make sure that A-PDF Content Splitter Services has finished processing all the files in the folder before you remove it.

Note: When you remove a watched folder, A-PDF Content Splitter Services does not delete the In and Out folders, their contents. You can delete these manually when appropriate.
